

MINUTES of the College Curriculum Committee September 16, 2010

1. Agenda approved.
[Minutes from March 2010 meeting were approved online by CCC.]
2. Welcome
 - a. Introduction of CCC members.
 - b. Reminder that faculty terms extend for 2 years (1/2 elected new each year), with a 2-term limit; student terms are a single year. Meeting times and days generally remain consistent.
3. Method of keeping minutes:

4. Setting the 2010-11 CCC agenda (Swenson):
Swenson emphasized importance of adhering to curriculum writing guidelines and December deadline for curricular changes for next academic year to pass CCC.
 - a. CISAH updates (Quispe-Agnoli):
Quispe-Agnoli reviewed administrative changes taking place in 2010-11 for CISAH, joint meetings of CISAH-AC and CCC, Faculty Learning Communities for 2010-11, SIRS evaluation procedures, CISAH teaching awards, need for departments to provide the same number of student seats regardless of potential cuts in graduate assistant levels.
