Associate Dean's Remarks

Block Tuition: Tuition model where students would pay for 15 credits and can take 12-18 credits as opposed to the current a la carte per credit hour. There was discussion about time to degree, blocks per each semester, revenue (OCCI), and implications of adoption.

The following New Academic Programs & Program Changes were approved:

- Request to delete the Graduate Specialization in Ethics and Development in the Department of Philosophy
- The request to change requirements for the Minor in Musical Theatre
- The request to change the name for the BA in Professional Writing to Public and Professional Writing as well as its new requirements.

Also, a request to postpone action was approved:

- The request to establish a Minor in Photography was postponed, at the request of Dean Sonja Fritzsche, until the November meeting.

The following New Courses and Course Changes were approved:

- Change to MUSM 492
- 30 WRA courses in Public & Professional Writing Program were changed/deleted
- 5 new WRA courses in the Public & Professional Writing Program were approved

Arabic Changes: Presented by Jason Merrill – increasing course requirements for the programs, and prerequisite, enrollment, frequency and recommended background changes for the courses

- Arabic BA, Arabic MNUN, ARB 460, & 461 – approved unanimously.
- GSAH 391 prerequisite change – approved unanimously with the addition of removing other processed proposals in #7.
- PRT 150 & 250 Title changes & credit model to make it more accessible to students – approved unanimously with the addition of updating #30 and the change in credit hours be added to #1 general reason.
