Styles of Leadership

<u>Delegating Style [PDF]</u>--can be used when things are calm, employees know their jobs well and direct supervision isn't required.

<u>Supporting Style [PDF]</u>-can be used when things are calm, staff may be new or experienced in

their jobs. Builds trust, communication, is transparent and creates an environment to promote a state of contentment, pride in workplace.

<u>Coaching Style [PDF]</u>-Helps employee develop skills and achieve goals.

<u>Directing Style [PDF]</u>-Use when external environment is turbulent and when employees are new and don't know their jobs well.
